We are currently looking for a full time Machine Operator/Warehouse Operative based in the Edmonton Service Centre. The Machine Operator will be responsible for operating the deep hole-drilling machine (BTA) and all associated drilling responsibilities, in addition to core warehouse duties.

Responsibilities:

- Set up and operate Unisig Deep Hole Drilling Machines
- Complete tooling changeovers
- Measure stock bar straightness using dial indicators to ensure the part is within drilling tolerance
- Organize and inventory drilling consumables and tooling
- Set up both fixed and cartage style drill heads
- Maintain required maintenance tasks daily, weekly, monthly
- Unload inbound trucks using forklifts and overhead cranes
- Review and understand customer tickets
- Locate material and verify grade, size and quantity by visually inspecting and physically measuring material
- Determine and safely operate the proper handling equipment to process each order
- Package and tag material per warehouse/customers instructions
- Willing to perform other jobs as needed based on qualifications
